- ALL GUESTS MUST PURCHASE THEIR DAILY PASS <u>INSIDE</u> THE FACILITY.
- OAC MEMBERS MUST ACCOMPANY THEIR GUESTS ON WEEKENDS.

OAC will close for the following reasons for the safety of our members and staff:

- When thunder or lightning is first noticed, pool activities will be suspended and all aquatic facilities will be evacuated until 30 minutes after the last sign of thunder or lightning. Rain limits the visibility of the pool.
- Sun, air temperature, water temperature and weather, that create adverse and hazardous conditions may cause changes in hours and amenities.
- Water contamination may cause the pool areas to be closed without notice. This is in accordance with Health Department guidelines and is for the safety of everyone.

OAC IS RESERVED FOR OAC MEMBERS ONLY.

In the event of an indoor pool closure (including the scheduled maintenance closure August 19 to September 2), YMCA members who have not purchased an OAC membership are welcomed to purchase an OAC membership or a daily guest pass to use the OAC. They are also invited to visit any of the other indoor pools in the Gateway Region YMCA Association.

PLEASE NOTE:

- No alcohol is permitted on premises
- No outside food or coolers allowed
- Inflatables including water wings, rafts, and inner tubes are not permitted in the pool. Flotation devices must be coast guard approved.
- Personal outside lounge chairs ARE permitted; we are not responsible for lost or damaged items.

OUTDOOR AQUATIC CENTER RULES

We strive every day to make your leisure experience safe and enjoyable. In order to better serve you and meet your needs, we ask you adhere to simple rules and guidelines that have been implemented for your safety. The YMCA Aquatic Center staff reserves the right to implement any rule or quideline in order to protect the health, experience, safety, and well-being of all facility patrons.

GENERAL POOL RULES

- Please walk on the deck.
- Diving is not permitted.
- Alcohol and firearms are not permitted on facility grounds.
- All food and snacks must be kept in the Urban Eats Snack Area.
- Appropriate swim wear must be worn in the pool. Gym shorts, cut offs, khakis, etc... are not permitted.
- White towels given in the facility are not permitted outside.
- All swimmers MUST take a soap shower before entering the pool.
- Breath holding and long periods of underwater swimming are not permitted.
- Sitting or hanging on lane lines or lifelines is not permitted. Do not remove any lifeline.
- Horseplay is not permitted in the pool or locker rooms.
- Inflatables, water wings, diving sticks, plastic water guns and rafts are not permitted in the pool area.
- Please notify the Manager on Duty if the main drain is not visible.
- If lightning is within 6 miles the pool area will close. This includes shower areas.

RULES REGARDING CHILDREN

- Children of diaper age MUST wear a swim diaper. These are available for purchase at the service center.
- No inflatable water wings are permitted. If using water wings they must be foam or covered in cloth.
- Children 5 years of age or younger must have an adult (age 18 or older) in the water with them within arm's reach at all time except the child play structure.
- Children 6 7 years of age must have an adult in the pool area at all times.
- Children 8 12 years of age must have an adult on the outdoor pool deck.
- Children 13 years and older may swim independently.

VORTEX AND LAZY RIVER

- Please keep head above water at all times.
- Please follow the direction of the current.
- Island between lazy river is off limits except to sunbathers.

YELLOW SLIDE

- Swimmers must be at least 48" tall to ride the yellow slide.
- Metal rivets in suits or trunks are not permitted.
- Please slide one at a time in a forward seated position, feet first.
- Do not kneel, rotate or stop on the slide while going down.
- Move away from the bottom of the slide immediately.
- Remove goggles, masks, glasses or flotation device before going down the slide.

KIDDIE PLAY STRUCTURE

- Child play structure is intended for ages 7 and younger. Parents must watch and attend their children in the play area at all times.
- Children must be 36" or taller to go down the small slide.
- Please no sitting on geysers or jets.
- Remove goggles, mask, glasses or flotation device before going down the slide.

LIFEGUARD AND/OR LIFEGUARD SUPERVISOR HAS FINAL AUTHORITY.

Any person who fails to comply by these or additional rules implemented by the staff will be asked to leave the Aquatic center and/or have their membership privileges suspended or canceled.
