Helpful to Know! Rules & Policies

Check-in time is 3:30 pm at the Lakewood Lodge main office on the Friday of your stay. Check-out time is 11:30 am on the last day. You are welcome to stay through the afternoon, but must vacate the cabins.

Alcohol consumption is not permitted anywhere on site by the Gateway Region YMCA Adventure Guides.

During your weekend at Camp Lakewood we provide continental breakfast Saturday and Sunday mornings at Lakewood Lodge, as well as Saturday lunch buffet. Sunday lunch buffet is optionally available at Trout Lodge for an additional \$5 per person.

Please note: There are no locks on the cabins due to the number of people staying in each cabin and for safety reasons.

We only allow driving on designated roadways, and parking in designated parking areas. Never drive or park on the grass.

We will provide a supply of firewood on Friday for use in the firepits. Additional loads of firewood will either need to be supplied by members of the Adventure Guides, or purchased for \$5/bundle.

Fires are to be built in designated areas or in raised firepits only. Ashes from firepits are to be placed only in designated ash cans.

Smoking is not permitted in cabins or public areas, and quiet hours are from 10 pm until 8 am every day.

Pets are not allowed, except qualified, documented service animals.

Adventure Guide adults should check their cabins upon arrival for broken windows, screens, etc., as damage during your stay may be applied to your total bill at the end of your stay. Each group is responsible for leaving camp as clean as they found it. Buildings, program areas and grounds should be clean before the group leaves them.

Some activities have age restrictions. Children below the minimum age outlined by our policies will not be allowed to participate in those activities under any circumstances.

If you cancel more than two weeks prior to the arrival date, you will be refunded all but \$25 of your total registration fee. If you cancel after that period, you will not receive a refund.
