Tickets: Tickets that normally cost \$40 or more each will be available to pre-order at a reduced rate of \$19 to anyone until July 7 from your local branch of the Gateway Region YMCA. Tickets will be available for pick up after July 15. If ordering online, please choose the YMCA branch where you want to pick up your tickets.

Parade: Registered YMCA program participants will be able to participate in a pre-game parade around the Cardinals playing field. Only coaches, camp counselors, or other pre-selected volunteer group leaders will walk in the pre-game parade around the Cardinals playing field.

Game Day: All parade participants are asked wear their YMCA shirts. Parents will meet the group leader from their YMCA branch inside Gate 1 at the southeast corner of Busch Stadium near Broadway and Poplar (I–64.) Gate 1 will open at 5:15 pm (earlier than other gates.) Tickets will be scanned as you enter.
