#### GO FOR GREEN! FREE Summer Day Camp Swim Lesson Program

We want to ensure everyone stays safe around water!

Did you know drowning is the leading cause of accidental death for children one to four years of age and the second leading cause of accidental death for children five to fourteen?

As part of our drowning prevention initiative at the Carondelet Park Rec Complex, day campers will participate in our "Go for Green" program. All campers will be swim tested at the beginning of each pool session, during their designated swim time. If a camper doesn't pass the swim test, they will participate in water safety classes with the goal of passing the Y swim test.

Classes begin the 1st week of camp. Each class will be 30 minutes and the remainder of the time in the pool will be free swim. All classes will have certified Y lifeguards and trained swim instructors. Once campers pass the swim test, they will have the ability to access any open area of the pool and will obtain their **green wristband**.

If your child is registered in swim lessons, we suggest you continue those as they provide more advanced instruction. For more information on our swim lesson program please visit our Welcome Center.

#### Inclusion Services

The YMCA provides inclusive programming and reasonable accommodations for all of our program participants. Completed forms must be submitted to the YMCA branch a minimum of two weeks prior to your child's expected camp start date. Factors affecting your child's start date include: late enrollment, submission of incomplete or out-of-date paperwork, and availability of appropriate staff to help facilitate your child's successful participation in the program. Paperwork is processed in the order received.

#### Age 5 Campers

All children age 5+ may attend a full day camp program provided they have completed a full day educational environment for at least one year prior to enrollment in day

camp programs. No naps provided. 5 year-old attendance will be evaluated on an ongoing basis to ensure a positive camp experience and child's readiness for full day activities. Camp is based upon chronological age, not developmental age. We may request that a birth certificate be presented for age 5 campers if needed.


